# LITTLE FISH

Ice-breaker/ Concentration

**Description:** Student A (Bill) begins by picking a random classmate, student B (Sam): “Sam, Big Fish”, and Bill holds both hands in front of the screen very small, about 3 inches apart. “Sam” then says “Bill, Big fish” with hands also small. Sam then passes to random student C (Keri) “Keri, Little Fish”, and hold both hands in front of the camera very big, about 15 inches apart. Kari says back to him “Sam, little fish” with hands wide. Players continue until all students have played.

**Possibilities:** Tiny tiny fish, whale, octopus, star fish, oyster, baby shark

**Discussion** Where was your focus? What was the purpose? How could you make choices that are more interesting? Can you think of a way to make it more challenging? What theatre skills does this game use?
