GREETINGS!

Description: Pick one student to start the game. Student A (Susie) will call on one person by name (Mike) and say: “Hello Mike, how are you?” in a particular way (*irritated*). Student B (Mike) will respond in the same tone/manner that was given to him (*irritated*): “Fine Susie, thanks”. Then student B (Mike) will call on a new student by name (Kelly), but in a different manner (*scared*): “Hello Kelly, how are you?”, and the game continues until all student have played.

Possibilities:

- greet each other like you greet a long lost friend
- greet someone you don` t really trust
- greet an ex-girl/boy friend
- greet someone you really hate
- greet someone you have a secret crush on
- greet someone with something in their teeth
- greet someone using any range of emotions
- greet someone like you are a cowboy, a soldier, a nanny, a Russian farmer,...

Discussion: Who needs to be concentrating? What should you listen for during the game? What purpose does it serve in acting? How could you make more interesting choices?

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
